BEHAVIOR EXPECTATION

Dream Center Peoria adheres to high safety standards and regulations. To create and maintain such an environment will require the participation of staff and students alike. Please read the following information carefully so you and your child can fully understand and agree to the expectations set forth by Dream Center Peoria.

Disciplinary Process:

Most disciplinary situations at our After School Program (ASP) are minor and can be resolved with minimal corrections. ASP staff use discipline as a learning opportunity for the students to try to integrate problem-solving skills into the discussion. However, if the negative behavior continues the following steps may be instituted.

- 1. Discussion between student and staff with set goals and objectives.
- 2. Discussion between student, staff, and director to clarify goals and objectives previously set by the parties involved.
- 3. If the conduct continues, documentation of the negative behavior will be recorded in the form of a Behavior Contract signed by the student, staff, and director.
- 4. Director will contact the parent/guardian to inform them of the situation and discuss possible options.
- 5. Program Director will contact parent/guardian to make arrangements for the student's discharge from the program.

Although the above steps may be implemented, ASP Administrative staff retains the right to take immediate action if the student's behavior poses a threat to their own safety, the safety of other students, or the ASP staff.

CELL PHONES ARE PROHIBITED AND SHOULD NOT BE USED DURING THE HOURS OF THE PROGRAM AT DREAM CENTER PEORIA.

Cigarettes, alcohol, illegal drugs, weapons, and sexually explicit material and/or behavior are grounds for immediate dismissal from the program.
